

**CFR RECOVERY HOUSE
TRANSPORTATION & PARKING POLICY**

1. Upon admission to CFR Recovery House all residents will be required to sign an informed consent waiver/release regarding transportation.
2. Residents are allowed to bring one vehicle to CFR Recovery House, provided that they show proof of ownership, current registration, valid driver's license and proof of current insurance.
3. Residents may provide transportation to fellow residents but are not required to do so.
4. Residents without a vehicle or valid driver's license are encouraged to use the public bus system, maps and schedules will be provided. If due to weather or any other reason the public bus system is not operating it is the resident's responsibility to arrange other means of transportation ahead of time so as not to be late for work or appointments.
5. At times, members of local AA/NA may provide transportation to outside meetings and or events. Residents and or groups of residents may accept this form of transportation.
6. CFR Recovery House Staff will not transport residents in their private vehicles. There will be no exceptions.
7. Parking is allowed on the north side of the Recovery House, or in front except during times of the snow removal ordinance.
8. No vehicles that are not in good running order are allowed.
9. Upon departure from the CFR Recovery House, residents are required to remove vehicle on or before his discharge date. Any vehicles left will be towed at the owner's expense.
